

## Class 1







## Class 3

We are very happy to be back in in Class 3. We have jumped straight into our new adventure story Journey by Aaron Becker and have made our predictions about the story based on clues.


In Maths, we are close to completing our topic on length and perimeter, ready for fractions!

In Religion we have reflected on the importance of Holy Week. We're looking forward all our new topics this term. Great start, Class 3!




## Class 4

In Maths, we have been learning all about algebra - it has been tricky at times, but everyone has enjoyed the challenge!


In Thursday's PE lesson, we had so much fun outside practising our tennis skills.
