School Building Fund

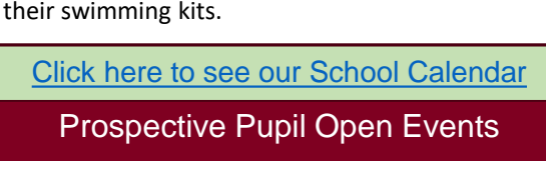
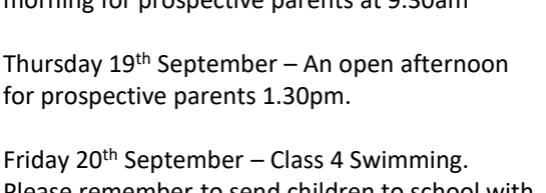
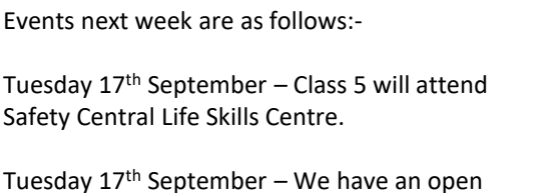
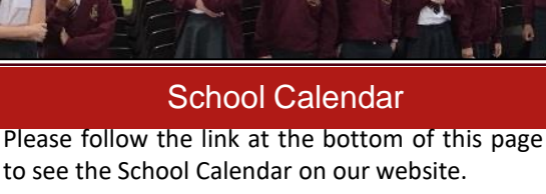
A letter and flyer have been sent home this week with information about the School Building Fund. We are extremely pleased that our pupils have featured in this leaflet.
