A faithful person is a gift to the world. Ask your child what the word 'faithfulness' means to them. Do they know someone who is faithful and who always keeps their promises? It may help your child if you can talk about a person you know to be a faithful friend, and say why.

To be faithful is to be true to someone or something. How can we grow in faithfulness to God and to each other? Perhaps we can: set aside a few minutes each day to pray to God and ask him to help us grow in faithfulness; follow the teachings of Jesus; keep our promises - making sure that if we tell someone [or we tell God] that we will do something, we do it!
